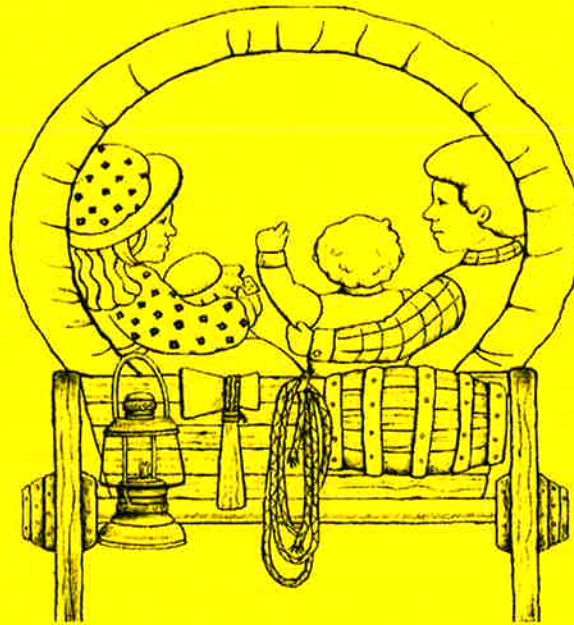

With great excitement in the air Monroe City's July 24th Celebration is upon us once again. With all that has happened recently with the Covid-19 pandemic it will probably be unlike one we have ever seen before. Monroe City feels it is important to carry on with tradition and provide an opportunity to celebrate as we have always done for those that are willing and able to participate. We feel confident that with proper guidelines and precautions it will be safe to do so. If you are concerned about the current health conditions, or are high risk we encourage and support your deci-

sion to not participate this year. You and many others will be missed, but the celebration is a part of who we are as Monroe City and we felt it important to provide the forum for celebration for the rest of our citizens. There will be slight deviations from the past schedule, but all activities previously held will continue EXCEPT the Ram Ride bicycle race and the Senior Citizens breakfast and lunch. Tickets for our fantastic raffle will be available for sale ONLINE ONLY at our website www.littlegreenvalley.com. The website will also have all celebration and activity information, schedules and links. One exciting addition will be that the parade will be televised on live TV on channel KTTA 8.1 this year. If you are watching the parade in person, please watch your children and make sure they maintain social distancing with others by staying with your immediate fami-

ly. Our city BBQ will go on as planned with those cooking and serving wearing masks. Tickets can also be purchased ONLINE. We encourage families to social distance from other families and households in all settings throughout the celebration. If you feel it appropriate, please wear a mask then it is recommended to do so. We will be using to-go boxes if you prefer to take your meal home. We will provide hand sanitizing and washing stations. We feel the fireworks will be able to be seen from your cars and your homes and encourage you to utilize those locations if at all possible. In the event health conditions change and our local health department advises us to modify our plans, we will adapt as necessary and ask for your patience and understanding as we do our best to provide a successful celebration for anyone we can. We look forward to seeing you all there!

Registration is live!!

With the support of Monroe City, we are ready to get this show on the road. Please understand that due to COVID-19 circumstances, we will not be ordering shirts this year. Registration will be cheaper. This decision was made in case the state, or our county, goes to the orange (or moderate) phase. The guidelines in place for that phase would disable us to host this event and debt in shirts would sink us. All money will be refunded if that is the case.

Registration will be more money the night of play at the table - we are trying to

keep social distancing measures in place and ask that you'd get registered to avoid large crowds in line at the table.

HEALTH AND SAFETY CONCERNING COVID 19

Participants will undergo a temperature and symptom screening check prior to event during the check in process. If any player has any of the following symptoms, he/she will not be allowed to participate and will be asked to leave:

Fever of 100.4 F or above

Cough (new, undiagnosed cough)
 Trouble breathing or shortness of breath
 Sore throat
 Sudden change in taste or smell
 Muscle aches or pains

Further measures for safety will be in place such as hand sanitizing after games and social distancing measures should be followed. Spectators should set up chairs to keep social distancing measures in place.

Sponsors and event facilitators will receive a shirt.
